I, on behalf of Shrimanta Shankar Academy, welcome you all to this grand occasion the 24<sup>th</sup> Annual day and Prize giving ceremony of our Academy. We are honoured by your gracious presence.

This is an occasion where members of a large family meet to build better fellowship. We have a common aim, the aim to see that an entire generation grows in harmony and goodness and become socially useful, productive human beings.

Shrimanta Shankar Academy, as the name implies is an unique blend of tradition and modernism. The founders of the school had the vision to name it after Mahapurash Sanakardev hoping to carry out his ideals and philosophy. Keeping this in view , the school strives to flourish and usher prosperity from all corners and for this, the teachers, students, guardians and the management are working in collaboration. Hope this collective endeavour will help to create socially useful productive human beings for the future society. The institution started its journey in the year 1995 with a handful of students, a few teachers under the able guidance of renowned educationists and administrators. Now in the year 2019 the Academy has more than 2500 students who are progressing towards the road of perfection under the able guidance of 127 devoted and dedicated teachers.

It is a pleasure for us to share with you the achievement of our students in the Board examinations. Like the previous years , this year also the pass percentage in both 10<sup>th</sup> Board Exam is 100. In the AISSE 2019,44 students scored 90% and above, 51 students scored in between 80% to 89.9%, 40 students scored in between 70% to 79.9%, 23 students scored in between 60% to 69.9%, 4students scored below 60%. Prithwis Das scored highest from SSA with 97.4%, Uddipta Rajkhowa is the second highest, scored with 97%, Md. Abdullah Bin Habib is the third highest, scored 96.2% . In the 12<sup>th</sup> Board Exam AISSCE 19 the pass percentage is 99.6%. 50 students secured 90% and above. 89 students secured in between 80-89.9%.69 students secured in between 70-79.9%, 31students secured in between 60-69.9%, 08 students secured below 60%.

The highest scorer from Science Stream are Shyamlee Tamuli & Bharat Agarwal . They have scored 96.4% . Manini Parashar is the highest scorer with 97% from Humanities and Sonia Kumari scored 95.4%,she is the highest scorer from Commerce. Shrimanta Shankar Academy takes pride that the students after completion of their school life at Shrimanta Shankar Academy are successful in getting berth and pursuing higher education in different prestigious colleges and universities.

While this brings joy, there is still the burning desire to achieve much more, so that we are able to give our best to the precious children you have placed under our care. School education cannot be confined to books and class-room activities alone. It must be a comprehensive programme for positive self development. CBSE has made it mandatory for all schools affiliated to it to make CCA an integral part of regular school curriculum.

Hence our school conducts CCA throughout the year with competitions to be held in the end of the session. As a result, our students have been doing well in several external competitions at the District, State and National level bringing laurels to their families and the Academy also.

We have children performing outstandingly in different sports and games , music , dance , Quiz ,creative writing ,debate , marching band , instrumental music etc.etc. It is shown in the screen .

We are proud to share with you that two students Bimrisha Bimal of Class X and Mayusha Kashyap of class IX had composed poem books KRISHNA –THE ETERNAL SAGA & SMELL THE ROSES respectively.

The list is long. All these achievements are shown in the school magazine Shankarian and news letter XTASY. Our heartiest congratulations to the proud parents of all these students.

We are not only proud of our students , our teachers are also excelling in different fields. Trinity Borgohain & Himasri Kalita had been awarded with Ph.D by Gauhati University .

In 2019 several activities along with regular routine work took place at Shrimanta Shankar Academy.
